Barker Public Library Tablet Lending Policy

The Barker Public Library is establishing this policy to provide computer tablets for use, to our patrons, both children and adults.

Tablets may be borrowed by Barker Public Library card holders of at least 18 years of age. Tablets for children may be checked out by parents or guardians meeting the requirements. All borrowers of tablets are required to sign the Library Tablet Loan Agreement. (addendum) This is an annual agreement.

Tablet checkout is limited to one device per household at any given time. The checkout period will be two weeks. Tablets are available on a first come-first serve basis. They may not be reserved.

The Barker Public Library is not responsible for any liability, damages or expense resulting from use or misuse of the device as well as any data loss. The Library is not responsible for downloaded content. Any use of the tablet for illegal purposes, unauthorized copying of copyright protected material, in any format, or transmission of threatening, harassing, defamatory or obscene materials is strictly prohibited.

Tablets must be returned to the circulation desk and not to the book drop or any other library. Tablets found in the book drop will be charged \$10.00 fee. Tablets returned late will be charged \$5.00 per day late fee to a maximum of \$100.00.

Tablets are expected to be returned exactly as they were received. All lost, damaged or stolen tablets will be replaced at the cost of the borrower.
