Furthermore, the library assumes no liability for any personal information that is compromised, or for any damage caused to hardware or software due to electric surges, security issues or consequences caused by viruses or hacking.

Library staff is not able to provide technical assistance to wireless users. While the library strives to provide a quality wireless system, it cannot guarantee the signal strength, bandwidth availability or general site availability at any time.

Printing is available via the public computers, It is not available via the wireless internet.

By accessing the wireless network, you are agreeing to comply with this policy as well as the library policies concerning use of the internet.
